2018 CIBC FIRSTCARIBBEAN INTERPRIMARY SCHOOL SWIM MEET

St. George’s, Grenada, June 7 & 8, 2018 - Over fourteen new records were set when the annual Inter-Primary Schools Swim Meet, took place recently.

Organised by the Ministry of Youth, Sports & Religious affairs, the Grenada Amateur Swimming Association and participating primary schools, the two-day event saw 270 students from twenty-three primary schools, throughout Grenada, Carriacou & Petite Martinique, gather to compete in approximately 46 events, and set over 14 new records!

The event has been sponsored for the past ten years by regional bank CIBC FirstCaribbean and its Country Manager, Mr. Nigel Ollivierre told the opening ceremony he was “pleased to see so many of you here and to have witnessed this event growing from strength to strength”.
